2. Get your mouth ready.



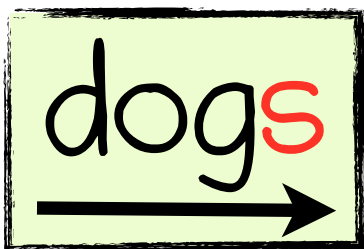
3. Ask yourself, "Does it make sense?"
